# Where We Serve Belem Brasil



- Classes began on January 22/24, but during the break, the children continued to receive reinforcement classes, sports activities, family cell group meetings, and visits to families.
- We currently have 9 boys and 1 girl, but our desire is to rescue more children from risky environments and attend to their needs
- In January, they received 15 textbooks and supplementary books according to their grade levels. They also received uniforms for daily wear, for physical education (including sneakers), and for the Junior Firefighter course. They receive a nutritious snack every day at school and lunch at Aunt Lenice's house. Two food baskets are provided per month for each family.
- In the afternoon session, they have reinforcement classes, table tennis, Junior Firefighter training, and soccer.
- Rock Smith lessons are being taught by our music teacher, Aniel Lima, not only for Project children but for all school students on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- We are covering the rent for Yuri and Yasmin's family who had nowhere to live.


- Priscila, Yuri's mother, has just given birth to another child, but the baby was born with syphilis, and both are hospitalized for treatment. We are providing the baby's layette, assisting with medications, and transportation. Priscila's other 4 children are with us while their mother goes through this.
- Paulo fell at school and broke his arm. We took care of him by taking him to the public hospital and buying medication. We are monitoring his progress. It was noted that he has very fragile bone structure and is malnourished.
- Bible study group every Tuesday evening for the children and their families.
- The mother of Fabrício and Pedro informed us that they will be moving to the south of Brazil in July. They were the first children in the Project Light, but God has given us peace, showing us that our time in their lives is coming to an end and that they are leaving this dangerous and challenging environment for a better place, a new life! This opens up an opportunity for two more boys from the "hostel of hell."
- We have other boys registered as candidates to join our project. We are in constant prayer for the Lord to raise up new supporters. We ask for prayers from our brothers and sisters as we face many battles to help these little Lights!
